The undersigned is informed and believes that:

COUNT 1

On or about October 21, 2025, in the above-named judicial district, the crime of VEHICULAR MANSLAUGHTER WITH GROSS NEGLIGENCE, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 192(c)(1), a felony, was committed by JashanPreet Singh, who did unlawfully, and without malice, kill Jaime FloresGarcia, a human being, while driving a vehicle in the commission of an unlawful act, not amounting to a felony, and with gross negligence; and while driving a vehicle in the commission of a lawful act which might have produced death, in an unlawful manner, and with gross negligence.

NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c) and 1192.8(a).

COUNT 2

On or about October 21, 2025, in the above-named judicial district, the crime of VEHICULAR MANSLAUGHTER WITH GROSS NEGLIGENCE, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 192(c)(1), a felony, was committed by JashanPreet Singh, who did unlawfully, and without malice, kill Lisa Nelson, a human being, while driving a vehicle in the commission of an unlawful act, not amounting to a felony, and with gross negligence; and while driving a vehicle in the commission of a lawful act

which might have produced death, in an unlawful manner, and with gross negligence.

NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c) and 1192.8(a).

COUNT 3

On or about October 21, 2025, in the above-named judicial district, the crime of VEHICULAR MANSLAUGHTER WITH GROSS NEGLIGENCE, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 192(c)(1), a felony, was committed by JashanPreet Singh, who did unlawfully, and without malice, kill Clarence Nelson, a human being, while driving a vehicle in the commission of an unlawful act, not amounting to a felony, and with gross negligence; and while driving a vehicle in the commission of a lawful act which might have produced death, in an unlawful manner, and with gross negligence.

NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c) and 1192.8(a).

COUNT 4

On or about October 21, 2025, in the above-named judicial district, the crime of RECKLESS DRIVING ON A HIGHWAY CAUSING A SPECIFIED INJURY, in violation of VEHICLE CODE SECTION 23103(a)/23105, a felony, was committed by JashanPreet Singh, who drove a vehicle on a highway in willful and/or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property proximately causing a bone fracture to Juan Chavez Alvarez and Tamara Lynn Gay.

It is further alleged as to count(s) 4 that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the defendant(s) JashanPreet Singh, personally inflicted great bodily injury upon Juan Chavez Alvarez, not an accomplice to the above offense, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.7(a). NOTICE: This offense is a serious felony and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code sections 1192.7(c)(8) and 667.5(c)(8).

It is further alleged as to count(s) 4 that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the defendant(s) JashanPreet Singh, personally inflicted great bodily injury upon Tamara Lynn Gay, not an accomplice to the above offense, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.7(a). NOTICE: This offense is a serious felony and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code sections 1192.7(c)(8) and 667.5(c)(8).

It is further alleged as to each count, pursuant to Penal Code section 1170, subdivision (b)(2), that the following circumstances may apply in this case:

- 1. The crime involved great violence, great bodily harm, threat of great bodily harm, or other acts disclosing a high degree of cruelty, viciousness, or callousness;
- 2. The defendant was armed with or used a weapon at the time of the commission of the crime:
- 3. The victim was particularly vulnerable;
- 4. The defendant was convicted of other crimes for which consecutive sentences could have been imposed but for which concurrent sentences are being imposed;
- 5. The defendant has engaged in violent conduct that indicates a serious danger to society; and
- 6. And any other aggravating factors that may be permitted by law.
