The undersigned is informed and believes that:

COUNT 1

On or about October 21, 2025, in the above-named judicial district, the crime of GROSS VEHICULAR MANSLAUGHTER WHILE INTOXICATED, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 191.5(a), a felony, was committed by JashanPreet Singh, who did unlawfully, and without malice, kill Jaime FloresGarcia, a human being, while driving a vehicle in violation of Vehicle Code sections 23140, 23152 and 23153 and said killing was the proximate result of the commission of an unlawful act, not amounting to a felony, and with gross negligence; and the proximate result of the commission of a lawful act which might have produced death, in an unlawful manner, and with gross negligence.

NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c) and 1192.8(a).

It is further alleged that during the commission of the above violation of Penal Code Section 191.5, the defendant JashanPreet Singh proximately caused bodily injury and/or death to more than one victim and is thus subject to the additional punishment provided for in Vehicle Code Section 23558.

COUNT 2

On or about October 21, 2025, in the above-named judicial district, the crime of GROSS VEHICULAR MANSLAUGHTER WHILE INTOXICATED, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 191.5(a), a felony, was committed by JashanPreet Singh, who did unlawfully, and without malice, kill Jane Doe, a human being, while driving a vehicle in violation of Vehicle Code sections 23140, 23152 and 23153 and said killing was the proximate result of the commission of an unlawful act, not amounting to a felony, and with gross negligence; and the proximate result of the commission of a lawful act which might have produced death, in an unlawful manner, and with gross negligence.

NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c) and 1192.8(a).

It is further alleged that during the commission of the above violation of Penal Code Section 191.5, the defendant JashanPreet Singh proximately caused bodily injury and/or death to more than one victim and is thus subject to the additional punishment provided for in Vehicle Code Section 23558.

COUNT 3

On or about October 21, 2025, in the above-named judicial district, the crime of GROSS VEHICULAR MANSLAUGHTER WHILE INTOXICATED, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 191.5(a), a felony, was committed by JashanPreet Singh, who did unlawfully, and without malice, kill John Doe, a human being, while driving a vehicle in violation of Vehicle Code sections 23140, 23152 and 23153 and said killing was the proximate result of the commission of an unlawful act, not amounting to a felony, and with gross negligence; and the proximate result of the commission of a lawful act which might have produced death, in an unlawful manner, and with gross negligence.

NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c) and 1192.8(a).

It is further alleged that during the commission of the above violation of Penal Code Section 191.5, the defendant JashanPreet Singh proximately caused bodily injury and/or death to more than one victim and is thus subject to the additional punishment provided for in Vehicle Code Section 23558.

COUNT 4

On or about October 21, 2025, in the above-named judicial district, the crime of DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF A DRUG CAUSING INJURY, in violation of VEHICLE CODE SECTION 23153(f), a felony, was committed by JashanPreet Singh, who did unlawfully, while under the influence of any drug, drive a vehicle and concurrently did an act forbidden by law, and neglected a duty imposed by law in driving the vehicle, which act and neglect proximately caused bodily injury to Maria Macias, Juan Chavez Alvarez and Tamara Lynn Gay.

You are hereby put on notice that being under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or both, impairs your ability to safely operate a motor vehicle. Therefore, it is extremely dangerous to human life to drive while under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or both. If you continue to drive while under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or both, and as a result of that driving, someone is killed, you can be charged with murder. (Penal Code section 189; People v. Watson, 30 Cal. 3d 290 (1981)).

It is further alleged that during the commission of the above violation of Penal Code Section 191.5, the defendant JashanPreet Singh proximately caused bodily injury and/or death to more than one victim and is thus subject to the additional punishment provided for in Vehicle Code Section 23558.

It is further alleged as to count(s) 4 that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the defendant(s) JashanPreet Singh, personally inflicted great bodily injury upon Tamara Lynn Gay, not an accomplice to the above offense, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.7(a). NOTICE: This offense is a serious felony and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code sections 1192.7(c)(8) and 667.5(c)(8).

It is further alleged as to count(s) 4 that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the defendant(s) JashanPreet Singh, personally inflicted great bodily injury upon Juan Chavez Alvarez, not an accomplice to the above offense, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.7(a). NOTICE: This offense is a serious felony and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code sections 1192.7(c)(8) and 667.5(c)(8).

It is further alleged as to each count, pursuant to Penal Code section 1170, subdivision (b)(2), that the following circumstances may apply in this case:

1. The crime involved great violence, great bodily harm, threat of great bodily harm, or other acts disclosing a high degree of cruelty, viciousness, or callousness;
2. The defendant was armed with or used a weapon at the time of the commission of the crime;
3. The victim was particularly vulnerable;
4. The defendant was convicted of other crimes for which consecutive sentences could have been imposed but for which concurrent sentences are being imposed;
5. The defendant has engaged in violent conduct that indicates a serious danger to society; and
6. And any other aggravating factors that may be permitted by law.
